Operational Rules & Regulations  
Marketing Only Stand***

1. Marketing Stand Application must be completed and returned with payment of \$600.00 to the address on the application.
2. All money received by the Greater Governor Mifflin League is used to offset the operating expenses, provide scholarships for continuing education and for contributions to various community organizations within the Governor Mifflin School District.
3. All stands must provide a certificate of insurance naming the Greater Governor Mifflin League as additionally insured.
4. Stands are not permitted to sell raffle tickets, use loud speakers to attract customers or display offensive materials.
5. A current year application must be completed including type of stand, stand dimensions (with trailer hitches and sides that swing out taken into consideration), and power requirements. **“Same as last year is not acceptable”**. Applications can be returned to the address on the application.
6. A separate application must be used for each stand.
7. The Stands and Grounds Committee will review stand applications.
8. The location of each stand on the midway is not guaranteed. Stand locations are subject to change *without* notice.
9. Stands may not set-up until after **12:00 noon** on the Friday before Community Days, July 1, 2022.
10. Hours of Set-up shall be as follows:

Friday	(6/30/23)	12:00 PM to 4:00 PM
Saturday	(7/1/23)	8:00 AM to 4:00 PM
Sunday	(7/2/23)	8:00 AM to 4:00 PM
11. Organizations must contact a Stands & Grounds member prior to setting up a stand.
12. There will be a \$20.00 electrical connection fee for each stand which must be paid prior to setting up stand.
13. Power may not be available until 4:00 PM on the Saturday before Community Days, July 1, 2023.
14. Electrical systems within stands must comply with the National Electrical Code and the electricians' requirements.

15. Hours of operation shall be as follows:

Monday	(7/4/22)	5:30 PM to 10:00 PM
Tuesday	(7/5/22)	5:30 PM to 10:00 PM
Wednesday	(7/6/22)	5:30 PM to 10:00 PM
Thursday	(7/7/22)	5:30 PM to 10:00 PM
Friday	(7/8/22)	5:30 PM to 11:00 PM
Saturday	(7/9/22)	5:30 PM to 11:00 PM

16. All stands must remain on the grounds overnight for the duration of Community Days.

17. All vehicles must be off the streets by 5:15PM Monday – Saturday and after closing no vehicles allowed on the street prior to 10:15 Monday – Thursday; Friday - Saturday no vehicles allowed on the street prior to 11:30PM

18. No one will be allowed to drive behind the stands to unload supplies or park their vehicles without prior approval from a member of Stands and Grounds.

19. All stands are required to take large cardboard cartons directly to the dumpsters or place them at the curb each night after closing. Do not place them in the trash barrels.

20. Power will be disconnected at 5:00 AM on the Sunday after Community Days, July 9, 2023.

21. All stands and supplies must be removed from the grounds by 12:00 PM Monday July 10, 2023 after the conclusion of Community Days.

22. All connections made to the water supply must be with hose approved for drinking water.

23. Overnight parking of recreational vehicles is not permitted.

24. Any questions or problems should be directed to the Stands & Grounds Committee for resolution.

**25. There will be no rain date. This includes fireworks.**

26. Any stand violating any of these operational rules and regulations, conducting its operation other than the way it was approved or not upholding the philosophy of the Greater Governor Mifflin League will be notified to close, leave the grounds and will not be invited to participate the following year.

27. The Greater Governor Mifflin League Board reserves the right to interpret, amend or add to these Operational Rules and Regulations.
